Musician Biographies

Pavel Jany: Pavel Jany's diversity and eclecticism in his guitar playing and composing have no boundaries, and his long musical journey encompasses many various styles. His classical guitar and compositional backgrounds were enriched by influences from East European Romani music of his native Czechoslovakia, to the works of jazz fusion auitarists Ralph Towner, Al Di Meola, Pat Metheny, Biréli Lagrène, and many Brazilian guitar masters. His three year stay in West Africa and his travels to Brazil and other South American countries deepened his interest in bossa nova, Afro-Brazilian and Latin music.

Pavel Jany has founded several international jazz projects on the Twin Cities' music scene, including Brazilian jazz ensemble "Ticket To Brasil", instrumental Gypsy jazz trio "Talking Strings", and modern jazz group "World Jazz Collegium".

Dean Harrington: Dean Harrington has been performing music with his own band Mill City Hot Club and other local groups playing swing, gypsy jazz, New Orleans jazz and more. He has been a guitar teacher for over 25 years at K & S Conservatory of Music and more recently Music Lab and Mount Olivet School of Music in Minneapolis.

And Now She Rises (Domestic Violence)

And most important of all: understanding. A survivor needs our willingness to see her reality and circle the wagons around her.

Together we can help turn a woman's pain into power. And that kind of positivity also affects the whole world.
