LAST CALL FOR PLEDGES DECEMBER 11, 2023

The Valley Session is in the process of finalizing the 2024 budget. Approximately 85% of Valley's 2024 budget income is derived from stewardship pledges. As a result, the stewardship goal for the current campaign has been set at just over \$436,500. To date, we have received stewardship pledges totaling roughly 83% of this goal!

But we are still waiting for over 30 pledges to come in from folks who have pledged in the past.




