Prayers for Charlotte Davnie who was diagnosed with breast cancer. She had a port put in on 12/4/23 and started her first chemotherapy infusion on 12/6/23.

The CT scan showed that the cancer spots in her lungs, sternum, and neck lymph nodes had all grown, along with some new spots in her neck and lungs, and a spot on her back or spine. A spot on one of her ribs which has actually led to a fracture in that rib. Her biggest ask is for prayers that this new drug works, the cancer stops growing, and that she can manage the side effect.


