

# A MESSAGE FROM THE PERSONNEL COMMITTEE INTRODUCING VALLEY'S TRANSITIONAL PASTOR, REV. JIM COCHRANE!

After interviewing three candidates in October and November (we were warned we might not even get a single candidate!), the Personnel Committee was thrilled to offer the role of Transitional Pastor to Jim Cochrane. He accepted (yay!) and Jim will be starting on February 1 at Valley.

Jim grew up in the Twin Cities area at Westminster Presbyterian Church in Minneapolis. He was very active in the youth group there and later was active with Clearwater Forest Camp. He actually got to know Peter and Martin Buller as they worked summers there together!

After graduating from Luther College in Decorah, IA, Jim worked as the Director of Christian Education for a church in Iowa City before later returning to the Twin Cities to run youth ministry for Westminster. In 2019, Jim moved to the Chicago area and started his studies at McCormick Theological Seminary in Chicago and began working as Associate Pastor at First Presbyterian Church of Lake Forest. In 2022, he earned his Master of Divinity and was officially ordained.



Jim and his wife Becca live in Chaska with their 19-month-old daughter Nora. They recently relocated back to the Twin Cities for Becca's job. Jim cannot wait to get to Valley and meet everyone and help us do the important work of readying the church to find our next Senior Pastor!

# Land Acknowledgement Task Force

In October, Valley helped to organize the **first annual Ḥaḥa Wakpadaŋ Water Ceremony** in Golden Valley. **This album** includes great photos from that morning by Stan Waldhauser. In 2024, the Task Force anticipates helping to organize a similar event on Indigenous Peoples' Day.

On November 11, Valley hosted a project capstone celebration for the "Exploring Haha Wakpadan" series that we conducted with Hennepin History Museum. Community partners gathered for an engaging discussion about how to continue raising awareness of Haha Wakpadan, the Dakota name for Bassett Creek. Several new initiatives are taking shape through momentum that Valley has helped to generate. Please keep your eyes open for more updates in the spring. Thank you to the St. Anthony Falls Heritage Board for its support.

And exciting news! We've completed the Haha Wakpadan / Bassett Creek Oral History Podcast. Check it out on **Spotify**, **YouTube**, or wherever you get your podcasts.

In partnership with Hennepin History Museum, we posted 15 interviews with Indigenous people about how they experience Haha Wakpadan as part of their historic and contemporary cultures. The interviews were conducted by Dr. Kasey Keeler (Tuolumne Me-Wuk and Citizen Potawatami). Popular episodes include well-known author Diane Wilson (Dakota) and educators Jim Rock (Dakota) and Roxanne Gould (Anishinaabe). For more information, see Valley's new land acknowledgement webpage.

On January 6, **Dr. Kasey Keeler will be speaking about her new book <u>American Indians and the</u> <b>American Dream** at the Minnesota History Center. Tickets are available **here** (virtual or in person).

In 2024, the Task Force anticipates sharing **a new logo design** to accompany the land acknowledgement statement. We're also exploring other ways to **support Indigenous artists**. 


