



Land Acknowledgement Task Force



The Land Acknowledgement Task Force is already celebrating an eventful 2024!

In January, Valley **donated \$50,000** from Barbara Johnston's estate to <u>Makoce Ikikcupi</u>, a Dakota land recovery project. Thank you to Jim Rock and Roxanne Gould for introducing us to this organization! The funds will be used to help re-establish a spiritual and physical relationship between Dakota people and their homeland.

In February, Jen Biggs introduced **Valley's new land acknowledgement logo** (left) during the Annual Meeting. We're grateful to **Dakota artist Wóokiye Win** (Katie Jo Bendickson) for designing the beautiful logo that references Hahá Wakpádan (Bassett Creek). More information about Wóokiye Win is available at www.wookiyewin.com. The logo is already being displayed in several locations throughout the church.

Also in February, Valley's Endowment Committee approved a grant for a textile artist to create a **land acknowledgement banner** for the downstairs entryway. The Task Force looks forward to starting the creative process with **Anishinaabe artist Summer Sky Cohen**. Please enjoy **this short video** to learn more about her artwork.


