

Islamophobia, the discriminatory behavior toward Muslims, has been increasing markedly in the U.S. Join us for an informational session on the impact this is having on local Muslims in our community. Our speaker, Tamim Saidi, is a 2018 Bush Fellow recipient, and comes to us from the Islamic Resource Group. He is the co-founder of NWICC Board (Masjid Al Kareem, in Plymouth) and a volunteer Imam at multiple local mosques.

Saidi, who fled Afghanistan as a teenager, plays an important leadership role here in the United States, focusing on education, student support and advancement, and community outreach. He also has a Doctor of Pharmacy degree from the U of MN.
