#### A LETTER FROM THE PASTOR

**APRIL 2025** 

Dear Valley,

If you haven't already heard it in my sermons these past few weeks, I have been wrestling with Lent this year. I have found myself at multiple points wanting to move away from the quiet introspection that normally comes with the Lenten season, wishing instead for the boisterous joy of Easter. There is a lot of gloom in the world already. Can't we just be happy?

I was feeling this way recently, so I decided to get out of the office and stretch my legs before evening meetings. I took a walk by the creek and thought of what that winding pathway might look like in just a few short weeks. Flowers would begin to creep out and tress would begin to bud; life would soon emerge! A hymn got into my head that I couldn't seem to shake either: In the bulb there is a flower, in the seed, an apple tree / in cocoons, a hidden promise: butterflies will soon be free! / In the cold and snow of winter there's a spring that waits to be / unrevealed until its season, something God alone can see.

We walk through Lent with quiet and restraint because it reminds us of just how joyful Easter really is. The seasons of dormancy in our lives juxtapose the upwelling of emotion

that comes with seasons that give life. God alone is able to see that wider, 30,000-foot view. It is incumbent on us to trust that it will eventually make its way out.

God alone can see the full arc of our lives and the joyful morning following the evening of despair, but we can see flashes of that life-giving joy at times. Here at Valley, we saw those lovely shimmers through events like the **Y.E.S. Tea** that raised over \$5,100 for future scholars of the church and our annual **Pack the Pews** campaign that delivered thousands of pounds of food and thousands of dollars in financial support to PRISM.

The hymn I mentioned, In the Bulb There is a Flower, ends with: In our end is our beginning, in our time, infinity / in our doubt there is believing, in our life, eternity / in our death, a resurrection, at the last, a victory / unrevealed until its season, something God alone can see. I hope you will join us here at Valley to celebrate the ultimate joy – that the love of God can conquer even the ultimate finality of death – this year for Holy Week. From the "Hosanna's" of Palm Sunday to the darkness of Maundy Thursday to the joy of Easter morning, we live grateful that God walks with us all in every season of our lives.
