A LETTER FROM THE PASTOR

MAY 2025

Dear Valley,

The question "Why Church?" has been rolling around in my head lately. Why do we gather on Sunday mornings? Why do we take time out of our busy lives for committee meetings and votes? Why do we give away part of our precious resources to this organization? When I asked a colleague that question, they pointed to the joy of Easter.

I am still basking in that Easter joy: from the laughter of young ones from our community and neighborhood hunting for Easter eggs, to trumpet prelude, to the Hallelujah chorus that filled the sanctuary on Sunday! The Egg Hunt was a hit once again as kids of all ages looked for eggs, and Easter morning worship was a beautiful celebration of the fellowship we have in the Valley Community and the unending love and power of God.

As we live into the Easter message that love cannot be conquered even by death, we recognize that God's beloved community does not stop at the doors of the church. For that reason, we at Valley look to how we can best care for the world around us.

The totals came in from our **Pack the Pews** campaign in March, which totaled nearly 1,000 pounds of food for our community partner PRISM. **Fridays in the Valley** has raised over \$2,000 for mission partners just in 2025 alone. Valley responds to calls for need.

There is also now a new need from one of our sister congregations, **Liberty Community Church**. They have an urgent need for new laptops so their 21st Century Academy scholars can get all the support they need to excel, and we are here to answer. In the month of May, we are raising \$8,000 to help them purchase these new computers. This is a crucial need for the continued success of one of Liberty's key programs, so I encourage you to consider what you might be able to give toward the cause.

As I've thought more and more about the question "Why Church?", the only answer I can come up with is "because the world needs it." We are an Easter people – a community that hangs its hat on the promise of a

hopeful tomorrow – and the world is in desperate need of hope now. We believe in caring for and uplifting all of God's children, and our world needs to better recognize the shared community we are all part of. We believe in serving before taking, and the world needs examples of selflessness and humility to the end of equity.

As we move into the spring and summer, I hope you will find a way to help us share that love with the world, whether volunteering for **VBC**, coming to our booth at **Golden Valley Pride Festival**, assisting in worship, or some other way! Together we can bring the message of God's unending love to the world around us.








Indigenous Justice Task Force

In April, the Indigenous Justice Task Force collaborated with the Twin Cities Repair Community to offer a presentation by Sarah Augustine, the executive director of the Coalition to Dismantle the Doctrine of Discovery. 350 people attended this presentation about embodying solidarity with Indigenous people. If you weren't able to attend, please enjoy **this recording** on YouTube.

In May, the Task Force is working on a \$5,000 grant from the Mississippi Watershed Management Organization. We're collaborating with Cassandra Roy (Anishinaabe) to **photograph** Hahá Wakpádaŋ / Bassett Creek in all 4 seasons. In September 2025, please keep your eyes open for an **art exhibit** at The Trailhead in Theodore Wirth Park. This fall, we'll also be hosting several **public presentations** with Roy about her artistic process.

The Indigenous Justice Task Force would like to extend a **huge thank you to the Endowment Committee** for supporting both of the initiatives listed above. The approval of grant requests submitted to Endowment allowed Valley to be a supporting congregation in Sarah Augustine's visit and to apply for the Mississippi Watershed Management Organization grant.


