#### PASTORAL NOMINATING COMMITTEE

While you haven't heard from the PNC in awhile due to the 4<sup>th</sup> of July holiday weekend and busy schedules for all, we have remained diligent in our search for a new Head Pastor!

Through the month of June and the beginning of July, PNC members have each spent hours of their own time, reviewing 8 applications, first reading PDP (Personal Discernment Profile) responses, researching and reading provided materials/website links, and watching recorded sermons. This was A LOT of information to process. The PNC then met to discuss candidates and decide which ones should move on to the interview process.

On July 16, the PNC conducted its first interviews with three candidates. Meanwhile, we received additional applications. At the end of July, the PNC conducted second interviews with three candidates, set up a first interview with a 4th candidate, and reached out to a 5th. We're coordinating PNC meetings and interviews in as timely a manner as possible.

While we're all anxious to move on to Valley's next chapter, choosing a new head pastor isn't something to be rushed, especially after saying good-bye to a beloved pastor of 20 years. The PNC feels deeply that this is a thoughtful labor of love, thus it will take time to find the right candidate. And we must do our due diligence on behalf of everyone involved - our Valley family, the PNC, the candidates, and the Presbytery.

As always, please keep the PNC in your prayers as we continue this process.






