

# **Indigenous Justice Task Force**

Happy fall, everyone! This is a busy season for the Indigenous Justice Task Force.

One exciting update is that in September, the **Golden Valley City Council** unanimously approved a **co-naming policy for the creek**. This means that the city will use "Ḥaḥá Wakpádaŋ /
Bassett Creek" when it talks about the creek. Please thank the
Golden Valley mayor, city commissioners, and Environmental
Commission for their actions.

If you live in a different city, please let us know! We'd love to see other cities adopt this co-naming policy, too. The watershed includes parts of nine cities: Crystal, Golden Valley, Minnetonka, New Hope, Medicine Lake, Plymouth, Minneapolis, Robbinsdale, and St. Louis Park.

- Now through October 31 Visit the portrait photography exhibit "Native Voices: Stories from Hahá Wakpádan / Bassett Creek" at <u>The Trailhead</u> in Theodore Wirth Park. This colorful exhibit features photographs by 3 Ojibwe photographers of people who provided stories for the oral history project. The photo included above is a sample. Valley is one of many partners on this exciting community project.
- <u>Sunday October 12</u> **Indigenous Peoples' Sunday**. Special **worship service** at 9:30am. Tasty cookies from Unci's Prairie Bakery during **Fellowship** at 10:30am. Cassandra will speak about her images featuring native plant relatives and Hahá Wakpádan / Bassett Creek with grant support from the Mississippi Watershed Management Organization. Jaida will share her portrait photographs of Indigenous water protectors and artists, including the textile artist who created Valley's land acknowledgment banner.




