The Missions Inc. Home Free Community Program is a community-wide response to domestic violence through coordination of law enforcement, criminal justice, and social service systems.

Services are provided to 11 cities and municipalities in northwest Hennepin County with expanded services using a domestic assault intervention project model in the cities of Plymouth, New Hope, and Champlin. Home Free Shelter serves female identifying survivors and their children. All services are free, confidential and voluntary, regardless of income or immigration status.

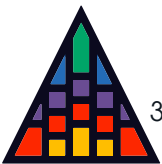
