Incoming Deacons

Was a Nanny for a family at Lake Calhoun for 18 years. I enjoy gardening, baking & reading. I especially like helping whenever & wherever I can. I am honored to serve as a deacon.

Jan Sacco, Deacon: My parents joined Valley in 1957, so I grew up in this community. I participated in Sunday school (Margie Deutsch was my fifth grade Sunday school teacher!), youth group, and became a Deacon. I wrote two musical plays that were produced at Valley back in the day. Incoming Elders

Jen Biggs, Mission Possible Elder: I grew up at Valley and returned as an adult member in 2016 with my children, Evan and Ty Miller (now 18 and 21, respectively). The welcoming community and Valley's deep commitment to mission are what keep me anchored here. Professionally, I have been a physical therapist for 28 years, and currently serve as the Program Director for the Doctor of Physical Therapy Program at St. Kate's. Jennie grew up at Valley and we were married in the sanctuary here in 1983. Having retired from Wycliffe we now live in Robbinsdale and have been members of Valley since 2022. I continue to volunteer with the organization as an exegetical editor of translation guides for mother-tongue translators around the world. Through the internet I also assist some of our Iyo friends as they translate the Old Testament. Besides all that I enjoy woodworking, construction projects, golf and reading.

Jamese Decker, Fellowship Elder: I was baptized at Valley in 2015 and after completing confirmation, I joined the church in November 2020. I have been active in TEAMS, Youth Group, went on mission trips and helped with the Y.E.S. Tea. Most recently I have been the Sunshine Room lead on Sunday mornings. After taking a year off from that role I am back. I'm excited to be on the Fellowship Team and learn more about what it takes to make Valley a great place.

Carolyn Anderson, Education Elder: My husband, Ray and I have lived in the VCPC neighborhood since 1976. After visiting Valley we were awed by the friendliness of the people and the mission of the church and joined Valley in 2013. I served two terms as a Deacon and joined Session in 2023 as an education elder. I spent my career working with parents of children with hearing loss and disabilities primarily at PACER Center. Since retiring in 2019, I've become active in organizations working for environmental justice, affordable housing, anti-racism, and plant-based eating. I enjoy making greeting cards, camping in our Scamp trailer, trying new recipes, and traveling. I'm looking forward to serving Valley as education elder for another three year term.
